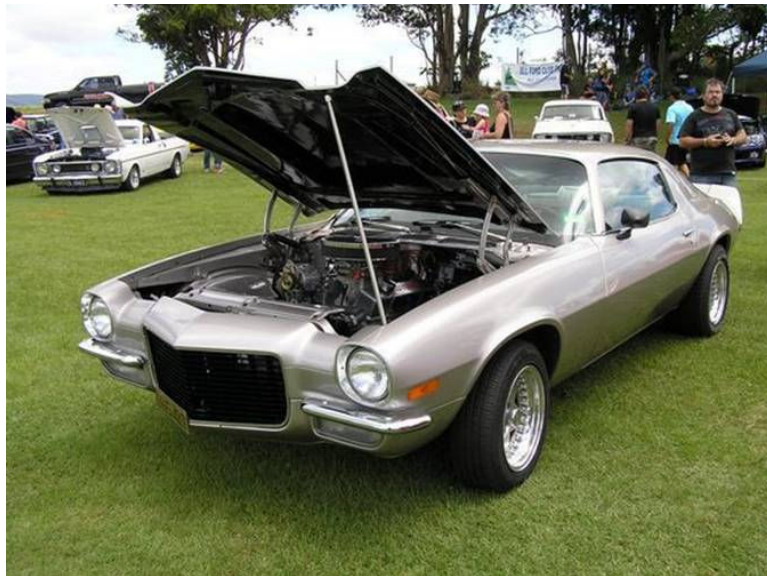


On Saturday night, there was a "Halloween Cruise". Some members met at Hungry Jacks carpark and then cruised along the Esplanade.
