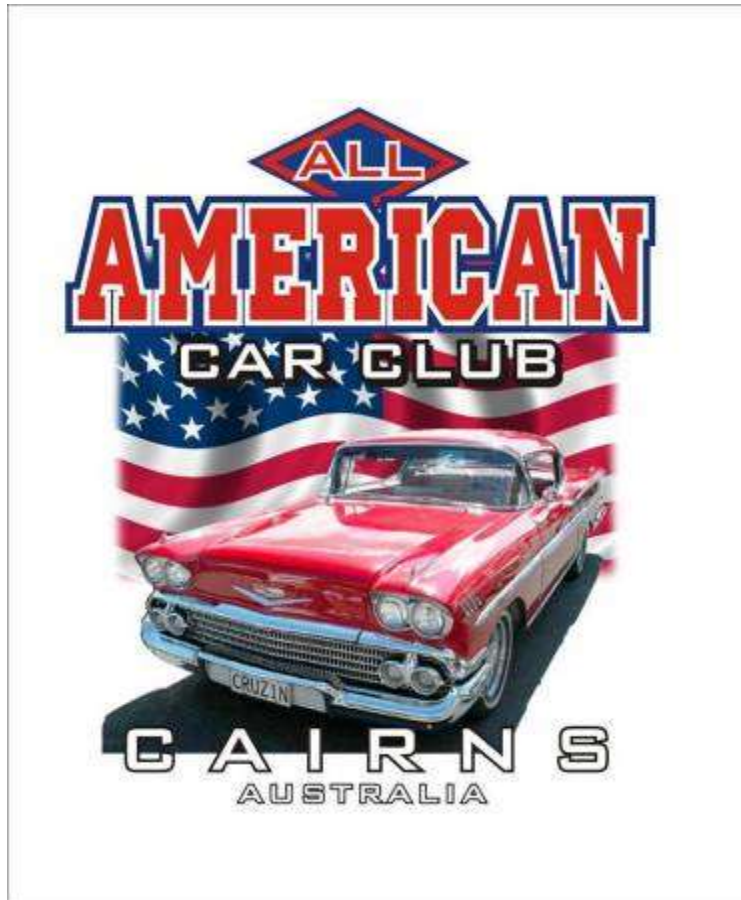

Many of our members participated in the survey conducted by the Australian Motor Heritage Foundation and the results have just been published. More than 6000 people from 800 clubs participated and the results revealed there are an estimated 970,000.00 historic vehicles in Australia with owners spending close to \$10,240.00 per vehicle per year. The historic fleet represents 4.4 per cent of Australia's 21 million total vehicle fleet. The survey also revealed that owners spend close to \$10 billion a year on their historic vehicles.
